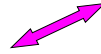
◆ OUR Cosmic Situation

◆ *Intuiting the Story WE are In*

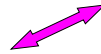
◆ OUR Vision of The Future

◆ *Committing to OUR Strategic Intentions, Character, Mission & Core Roles*

The core civilizational mission we will pursue, the principles that will guide us and the core roles we will play in our lives, families, organizations, communities and governments.



◆ Our Truly Strategic Goals

The society-shaping projects (strategic initiatives) we must now undertake and the differences they will make both within and among us. The major results (outcomes and outputs) we are committed to achieving over several [3-10] years.



◆ *Committing to Our Core Strategies*

The major approaches (management strategies / policies) we will always utilize in order to pursue and achieve our goals. The resources, structures, relationships and rules we will utilize. The metrics and standards by which we will measure progress.



◆ Our Operational Objectives

The immediate projects we will undertake over the next 1– 36 months to enact our strategies. The results (outputs and outcomes) we are committed to achieving during this time.



◆ *Planning Our Work*

In order to achieve our objectives, who will do what, by when, with whom, using what resources and with what intended results? The operational procedures, decision rules, measures and regulations that will guide our activities.



◆ Our Operations

The people, understandings, capital, resources, structures, time, technologies and partners we will utilize to do the work.



◆ *Doing Our Actual Work*

The visible activity in which we engage, guided by all of the above, plus our operational procedures, rules, regulations, understandings and attitudes.



◆ OUR Actual Emerging Future

The world we are actually co-creating and what we are actually becoming – for good and ill.
